Scholarship Eligibility

High School Seniors...

...who are accepted at a post secondary institution

APPLICATION:

The applicant must submit the following materials to be eligible for a scholarship.

- 1. A completed application form (To request a form, contact Kay Vega, Lakewood Theatre Company.)
- 2. An official High School transcript
- 3. A brief (max 2 pages typed) essay describing past courses of study, intended areas of study at the post-secondary institution/college/university, and the reasons the applicant wants to continue on to higher education. The applicant will include past courses of study and influenced future goals, and any involvement with Lakewood Theatre Company.
- 4. Participate in a structured interview.

SELECTION:

Only applicants with a complete application package, submitted to the Lakewood Theatre Company by MARCH 14TH of the current year, will be considered. Selection based on:

- 1. the responses on the application form
- 2. the quality of the essay
- 3. the quality of the responses in the interview
- 4. the strength of the recommendations
